1:		<p>Arrival Cape Town Airport</p> <p>Transfer to hotel to check in and unpack</p> <p>Walking tour of Cape Town</p> <p>Dinner at a Waterfront restaurant</p> <p>Overnight Fire &amp; Ice Hotel - CT</p>	<p>Enjoy the sights and sounds of one of the world's most beautiful cities as you explore it on foot (time dependant). Includes a visit to the Castle of Good Hope, slavery sites, the Parliament Buildings and District Six Museum.</p> <p>Head to the V&amp;A Waterfront for a walk around and dinner.</p>
2:		<p>Breakfast</p> <p>Robben Island Tour</p> <p>Guided hike up Table Mountain</p> <p>Dinner at Gold Restaurant</p> <p>Overnight Fire &amp; Ice Hotel—CT</p>	<p>Take a boat ride across the ocean to visit historical Robben Island, where Nelson Mandela was imprisoned.</p> <p>An exciting hike to the top of Table Mountain where you can explore and enjoy the magnificent views. Enjoy a picnic lunch on the mountain.</p> <p>Enjoy traditional African cuisine at this exciting restaurant!</p>
3:		<p>Breakfast</p> <p>Depart for Cape Point and Betty's Bay</p> <p>Kogelberg Biosphere</p> <p>Dinner and overnight in Hermanus</p>	<p>Take Chapman's Peak Drive to Cape Point where two oceans crash and meet. Then onward to Betty's Bay to get close to around 5000 African penguins before heading for Kogelberg Biosphere (this UNESCO World Heritage Site has more plant species than many countries). End your day in Hermanus for some land-based whale watching.</p>
4:		<p>Breakfast</p> <p>Early departure for Gansbaai or hang in Hermanus and watch for whales.</p> <p>Depart along Route 62 towards Oudtshoorn</p> <p>Dinner and overnight in Oudtshoorn</p>	<p>The adventurous will get transferred to Gansbaai to go cage diving with the Great White Sharks (optional activity), or spend the morning wandering the cliff paths looking for whales.</p> <p>Head along South Africa's famous country road and view high mountains, rugged plains, vineyards and orchards. Stop at a famous pub for a drink along the way.</p>

5:		Breakfast Optional elephant experience Ostrich farm visit Cango Wildlife Ranch Cango Caves Dinner and overnight at Myoli Beach	<p>Get to know these gentle giants up close and personal!</p> <p>We tour an ostrich farm, where the more daring can ride an ostrich (within weight limits), and get a picture taken kissing the world’s most friendly ostrich—Betsie.</p> <p>The Wildlife Ranch is a sanctuary to some of the world’s most endangered animals (optional extra)</p> <p>The Cango Caves are an illuminated wonderland of subterranean magic and mystery. The tour will explore the narrow passages and vast halls filled with colorful ancient stalactites.</p>
6:		Breakfast Wilderness National Park Knysna Bloukrans Bungy Jump Tsitsikamma National Park Dinner and overnight at Storms River	<p>Optional canoe on the Wilderness lagoon or go hiking in the forest.</p> <p>The popular town of Knysna calls for a stop at the Heads, where the sea crashes through two massive sandstone cliffs.</p> <p>Face your fear and jump from the world’s highest bungy jump (optional extra).</p> <p>Spend time in paradise as you explore the Tsitsikamma National Park. Walk along forest trails to a suspension bridge and find quiet spots to absorb the beauty of this gorgeous place.</p>
7:		Breakfast Waterfall Zipline or forest walk Surfing and shopping in Jeffrey’s Bay Dinner and overnight at Jeffrey’s Bay	<p>The 8 slides, of which the longest is 211m, zigzag along cables across the river gorge (optional extra). If you don’t want the zipline experience, then you can go for a walk in the forest.</p> <p>We will stop in Jeffrey’s Bay where you can go shopping for specials at the Billabong, Rip Curl and Quicksilver factory shops. Spend the afternoon having a swim or surf!</p>

8:		Breakfast Depart Jeffrey's Bay for Addo Elephant Park Game drive Dinner and overnight Addo area	Enjoy a 3-hour drive in Addo National Park (in tour bus) - Addo Elephant National Park was proclaimed in 1931 to provide a safe haven for the few wild elephants who survived government-sponsored culling to remove them in the early 20th century. Today the elephants number in their hundreds. Our tour concentrates on finding and viewing these elephants
9:		Early Breakfast Early morning game drive in Addo National Park Schotia Private Game Reserve Dinner and overnight Addo area	Schotia is a private game reserve and we can take our guests as close as possible to get the best viewing of rhino, hippo, giraffe and the king of the beasts, lion! The tour starts in the late afternoon.  This is a 4-hour guided game drive in an open Land Rover. After an amazing experience where you will view more animals than you thought possible, enjoy a delicious dinner which is prepared over an open fire.  A short, spotlight night drive providing the possibility of more nocturnal animals completes your experience.
10:		Breakfast Transfer from Addo on to Chintsa Afternoon orientation and beach games Dinner Overnight at Buccaneers	Enjoy the scenic drive from Addo and continue on to Chintsa.  The afternoon is spent "finding your feet" and learning about the project and covering all the operational guidelines during orientation, and enjoy some beach games in the late afternoon.  Introduction to IsiXhosa, the local language.

11:		Breakfast Depart for project "Transforming Learning & Sporting Environments" Lunch Project continued Visit to Giant Sand Dune Dinner Overnight at Buccaneers	30 minutes drive to site. Today's tasks will include preparing the area for the jungle gym and play areas that will be developed. Typical work will involve removing the "clutter" around the school, understanding the design plan and marking out the design. Picnic-style lunch at the school. Enjoy the Chintsa sunset while you enjoy a beach walk home.
12:		Breakfast Depart for project "Transforming Learning & Sporting Environments" Lunch Project continued Dinner Overnight at Buccaneers	30 minutes drive to site. Getting physical today we begin the hole digging, cement mixing and pole work for the construction of the jungle gym. Lunch at Buccaneers Wetsuits on and hit the beach for the afternoon where you will learn about the ocean while learning to surf. Other beach games on the go too.
13:		Breakfast Depart for project "Transforming Learning & Sporting Environments" Lunch Project continued Cultural tour and traditional dinner Overnight at Buccaneers	30 minutes drive to site. Keeping it physical today we continue the hole digging, cement mixing and pole work for the construction of the jungle gym. Picnic-style lunch at the school. A late afternoon walk through the rural village of Ngxingxolo ending at the legendary Mama Tofu where we have a dinner of traditional Xhosa food, prepared on open fires. Depart village after dinner arriving home for a well earned rest!

Continue with project tasks as needed.  Lunch at Buccaneers  Head out to the start of a beautifully scenic hike along our coast, with an informative talk and discussion of our region.
15:		Breakfast Depart for project “Transforming Learning & Sporting Environments” Lunch Project continued Dinner Overnight at Buccaneers	30 minute drive to site.  As your last day on site, you will have the final objectives set by our team leaders which will ensure your overall efforts reach a point of completion. Enjoy your time in the village!  Picnic-style lunch at the school.
